

## 2023 ADMINISTRATOR OF THE YEAR AWARD APPLICATION GUIDELINES

- The Administrator must have been engaged in French Second Language education, in any manner, at the school, school board or Department of Education levels;
- Must be regarded as a champion for French Second Language Education by his/her peers.

#### **SELECTION CRITERIA**

• ENGAGEMENT IN FRENCH EDUCATION (30%)

Factors to be evaluated include active participation in the promotion of linguistic and cultural duality in the province, strong support to French Second Language teachers, and concrete involvement to encourage students' love of French.

• LEADERSHIP (20%)

All leadership courses, roles or initiatives completed by nominee will be included as part of the evaluation of the application.

# • CONTRIBUTION TO THE PROMOTION OF FRENCH AS A LIVING LANGUAGE AND OTHER COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT (25%)

Active contribution to Canadian Parents for French programs and activities, the provincial Concours d'art oratoire or the Heather Huxter Memorial Story Writing Contest for instance, and any associated volunteer work will be evaluated under these criteria. Factors to be evaluated include active participation in the promotion of linguistic and cultural duality, going above and beyond to offer a variety of opportunities for youth to experience French as a living language.

Participation in activities to improve the well-being of the community at large is an inherent factor in the assessment of this criteria.

### • OUTSTANDING ACHIEVEMENTS (25%)

Awards, certificates and letters of commendation for any specific area or purpose should be included in the application.
