

## 2023 STUDENT OF THE YEAR AWARD APPLICATION GUIDELINES

- Student must be registered in Grade 12 during the 2022 2023 academic year and enrolled in a French Language education program;
- Accepted to a recognized post-secondary institution

#### **SELECTION CRITERIA**

• EXCELLENCE IN FRENCH (30%)

Factors to be evaluated include academic average in all French courses taken at the high school level, achievements in French, extracurricular activities in French, active participation in the promotion of linguistic and cultural duality, travel or residence in a French-speaking community.

• ACADEMICS (20%)

Grades in mathematics, language arts and science are also part of the assessment. Other considerations around level of learning, average of all courses, degree of difficulty and teachers' comments are parts of the criteria.

# • CONTRIBUTION TO THE PROMOTION OF FRENCH AS A LIVING LANGUAGE AND OTHER COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT (25%)

Active contribution or participation to Canadian Parents for French programs and activities, the provincial Concours d'art oratoire or the Heather Huxter Memorial Story Writing Contest for instance, and any associated volunteer work will be evaluated under this criteria. Factors to be evaluated include active participation in the promotion of linguistic and cultural duality in Newfoundland and Labrador.

Participation in activities to improve the well-being of the community at large is an inherent factor in the assessment of this criteria.

### • OUTSTANDING ACHIEVEMENTS (25%)

Awards, certificates and letters of commendation for any specific area or purpose should be included in the application. Personal challenges encountered and how they were dealt with will be taken into consideration.
