

2023 TEACHER OF THE YEAR AWARD APPLICATION GUIDELINES

- Teacher must have taught at least two (2) French courses in the 2022-2023 academic year on a full-time basis;
- Holding a teaching certificate.

SELECTION CRITERIA

• EXCELLENCE IN FRENCH EDUCATION (30%)

Factors to be evaluated include French courses taught, teaching methods, active participation in the promotion of linguistic and cultural duality in the classroom, and impact on students' love of French, travel or residence in a French-speaking community.

• LEADERSHIP (20%)

All leadership courses, roles or initiatives completed by nominee will be included as part of the evaluation of the application. This also includes mentoring of students and interns, curriculum development, roles within French Language education outside the classroom.

 CONTRIBUTION TO THE PROMOTION OF FRENCH AS A LIVING LANGUAGE AND OTHER COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT (25%)

Active contribution to Canadian Parents for French programs and activities, the provincial Concours d'art oratoire or the Heather Huxter Memorial Story Writing Contest for instance, and any associated volunteer work will be evaluated under this criteria. Factors to be evaluated include active participation in the promotion of linguistic and cultural duality, going above and beyond to offer a variety of opportunities for youth to experience French as a living language.

Participation in activities to improve the well-being of the community at large is an inherent factor in the assessment of this criteria.

OUTSTANDING ACHIEVEMENTS (25%)

Awards, certificates and letters of commendation for any specific area or purpose should be included in the application.
