



## 2017 PROVINCIAL AWARDS CELEBRATING EXCELLENCE

Canadian Parents for French - Newfoundland and Labrador recognizes, on an annual basis, volunteers, students and teachers for their efforts and contribution to the promotion of French education in the province.

### VOLUNTEER OF THE YEAR

Canadian Parents for French - Newfoundland and Labrador **Volunteer of the Year Award** recognizes a member who has contributed significantly to the advancement of French as a Second Language (FSL) in their community and the province while performing many other acts of volunteerism within schools and the community-at-large.

The Volunteer of the Year receives \$1,000 (\$500 cash prize / \$500 to French-supporting organization).

### STUDENT OF THE YEAR

Canadian Parents for French – Newfoundland and Labrador **Student of the Year Award** acknowledges a student enrolled in a French Second Language (FSL) Program (French immersion or Core French) who has excelled in their French studies while playing a very active role in their school and in their community.

The prize for Student of the Year is a \$1,000 scholarship to a post-secondary institution of their choice.

### TEACHER OF THE YEAR

Canadian Parents for French – Newfoundland and Labrador **French Teacher of the Year Award** is open to both core French and French immersion teachers. The award recognizes a teacher who has initiated new French Second Language teaching methods, motivated students to excel and made significant contributions to their school and the community-at-large.

Canadian Parents for French - Newfoundland and Labrador is offering a \$1,000 voucher for professional development to the French Teacher of the Year.

## TEACHER GRADUATE OF THE YEAR

Canadian Parents for French – Newfoundland and Labrador **Teacher Graduate of the Year Award** recognizes a graduate who has, during their academic and internship sessions, developed innovative strategies that illustrate their motivation to teach and demonstrate their passion for language development.
