



2017 STUDENT OF THE YEAR AWARD APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Student must be registered in Grade 12 during the 2016 - 2017 academic year and enrolled in a French Immersion or Core French program;
- Open to students whose parents are Canadian Parents for French members or whose school is a registered Canadian Parents for French Associate Member Organization; and
- Accepted to a recognized post-secondary institution.
- A letter on official school letterhead is required from the School Principal or French Teacher confirming that the student is enrolled in an French Second Language program.

SELECTION CRITERIA

- ***EXCELLENCE IN FRENCH (30 points)***

Factors to be evaluated include academic average in all French courses taken at the high school level, achievements in French, extracurricular activities in French, active participation in the promotion of linguistic and cultural duality, travel or residence in a French-speaking community.

- ***ACADEMICS (20 points)***

Grades in mathematics, language arts and science are also part of the assessment. Other considerations around level of learning, average of all courses, degree of difficulty and teachers' comments are parts of the criteria.

- ***CANADIAN PARENTS FOR FRENCH AND OTHER COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT (25 points)***

Membership in Canadian Parents for French - Newfoundland and Labrador, associated volunteer work, participation at the Chapter level, Concours d'art oratoire, fundraising, or any other activities will be evaluated under this criteria. Evaluation of volunteer work for organizations, clubs, and other associations as well as any contribution to senior citizens, hospitals, for instance, will also be included under this category.

- ***OUTSTANDING ACHIEVEMENTS (25 points)***

Awards, certificates and letters of commendation for any specific area or purpose should be included in the application. Personal challenges encountered and how they were dealt with will be taken into consideration.
