## **2017 TEACHER-GRADUATE OF THE YEAR AWARD APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS**

- The nominee must be completing a Bachelor of Education program with Core French or French Immersion as a teachable subject area, Spring 2017 Convocation and applied for a Newfoundland and Labrador teaching certificate; **OR**
- Completed the Bachelor of Education program with Core French or French Immersion as a teachable subject area, Fall 2016 Convocation and received a Newfoundland and Labrador teaching certificate;
- Open to teachers who are Canadian Parents for French members or whose school, where they are teaching, is a registered Canadian Parents for French Associate Member Organization.

### **SELECTION CRITERIA**

- ***EXCELLENCE IN FRENCH EDUCATION (30 points)***

Factors to be evaluated include French courses taught, teaching methods, active participation in the promotion of linguistic and cultural duality in the classroom, and impact on students' love of French, travel or residence in a French-speaking community.

- ***LEADERSHIP (20 points)***

All leadership courses, roles or initiatives completed by nominee will be included as part of the evaluation of the application. This also includes mentoring of interns, curriculum development, roles within French Second Language education outside the classroom.

- ***CANADIAN PARENTS FOR FRENCH AND OTHER COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT (25 points)***

Membership in Canadian Parents for French - Newfoundland and Labrador, associated volunteer work, participation at the Chapter level, Concours d'art oratoire, fundraising or any other Canadian Parents for French activities will be evaluated under this criteria. Evaluation of volunteer work for organizations, clubs, and other associations will also be included under this category.

- ***OUTSTANDING ACHIEVEMENTS (25 points)***

Awards, certificates and letters of commendation for any specific area or purpose should be included in the application.
