POSITION SUMMARY

Volunteers must be comfortable working with young kids and in both French and English.

We are recruiting for volunteers who can dedicate 1 to 2 hours per week for our fall program. Volunteers choose their own schedule each week. This program runs 6 days a week. This program will run from September 14 to mid-December. Orientation and training provided to all volunteers. This position is virtual and tutors will work with kids across Canada to help them maintain their French via Zoom.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Strong spoken and written French and English is a needed. Tutors will be working in both official languages.
- Prior experience working with children and youth is encouraged.
- Must have access to a computer, laptop or tablet with a microphone and camera.
